Celebrating Community Woman to Woman: The 5771 Torah Fund Pin commemorates the energizing power of women's community. *Kehillah kedoshah* was the common term for Jewish community in Eastern Europe, but it also implies a community bound together by similar values and beliefs. The images contained within this stylized hamsa pin reflect women in celebration, dancing and praising. The pin's golden flame, representing the Women's League logo, alludes to our members who are committed to a common purpose and the unbreakable bonds of sisterhood.

WHEN?

Launched in 1942, the Torah Fund Campaign started as a scholarship fund. In 1963 it merged with the Mathilde Schechter Residence Hall campaign to provide housing to undergraduate students. Since then the Torah Fund has undertaken important projects such as:

- Creating the Women's League Seminary Synagogue
- Thousands of library bookshelves
- Women's League Educational Pavilion
- Residence halls at University of Judaism, Schechter Institute and JTS
- Scholarships in order to secure our future leaders!
